## 5. Principal Report - Dave Armbruster

**Off to a Good Start -** We have had a great start to this school year and it's hard to believe that we are almost to the middle of September already! We have a wonderful and dedicated group of staff working with your children, and I'm thankful to be able to work with this fantastic staff and with your wonderful children!

**Current Enrollment -** As of September 12, 2023 we have 113 students attending Bruderheim School!

**TIGER Traits** - Teamwork, Integrity, Grit, Empathy, Respect are a continued focus for us this year. A common language amongst students and staff, something we all strive to demonstrate, and also connects with our School Motto of **Be Your Best!** Our **TIGER** Trait Assemblies will be held during period 7 on the first Wednesday of each month and will be followed by student mentorship.

**Student Mentorship -** Our Gr. 1/2 class is partnered with our Gr. 4/5 class, and our Gr. 2/3 class is partnered with our Gr. 5/6 class. In addition, on select Fridays, each class will take turns mentoring/interacting with our Kindergarten students.

**Swimming Lessons** - For Grade 1-6 students and the same format as last year - three double sessions during the month of October. Prices per student have gone up by \$1.02 per student from last year and are now \$34.32 per student. Transportation costs will be similar to last year.
